as Veal By Virtue of a warrant N^o 88 Bearing Date on the
Tenth Day of August 1778 Beginning at his own corner a
Maple in Robert Freemans line then with ^{his} line North
Twenty four degrees West Seventy Six pole to a pine my corner
then North Sixty Seven degrees West along my own line Seventy
Seven pole to a sweet gum my corner in William Ruffins
line then South forty seven degrees west along the S.
Ruffins line Seventy Eight pole to four trees in his line two
Maples a red oak and poplar then South Seventy five degrees
East one hundred & seventy pole to the first Station
