Subject: Change of duty.

1. When directed by the Chief of Naval Operations, you will regard yourself detached from temporary duty in Naval Operations, Navy Department, and from such other duty as may have been assigned you; will proceed to Pact via such transportation including government or commercial air, highest priority, as may be furnished by the Bureau of Naval Personnel, or as you may find available, and upon arrival report to the Commanding Officer, Pact, for duty.
2. You are hereby authorized to perform such travel including air as may be necessary in the proper performance of your duty.
3. You will submit on the last day of each quarter a written report giving the information called for by Form BNP 330.
4. During the necessary travel time and while on temporary duty for a period not exceeding 90 days, and while traveling after reporting at your new permanent station, you will be entitled to transportation and a per diem of \$7.00 in lieu of subsistence, except while occupying government quarters ashore, when the per diem will be \$3.00, and except while in a vessel or while on authorized delay or leave when no per diem will be allowed. When the per diem allowances prescribed by the Secretary's letter of November 11, 1943, promulgated in BuPers Circular Letter No. 234-43 are in excess of the above per diems, such allowances are authorized in lieu of these per diems.
