

MINUTES OF MEETING OF EXECUTIVE BOARD OF ELMHURST GARDEN CLUB
Greenville, N. C.

September 17, 1959

The Executive Board of the Elmhurst Garden Club met Thursday, September 17, 1959, at the home of Frances Wilson with six members present.

The board recommended that we add a corresponding secretary to the slate of officers.

A provision was made in the by-laws that with the approval of the board an active member, if she so desires, may remain a member of the Elmhurst Garden Club if she moves from Elmhurst.

The president also read a letter from Mrs. Russell Bryant, our district leader.

Our club has been asked to buy "The National Gardener" for each officer. The board recommended that we not do this.

Thelma Whitehurst reported we have a balance of \$37.38 in our treasury.

Dues must be paid by December first.

Billie Mitchell will be in charge of our Christmas workshop at our November meeting. The board recommends an all day meeting with each member bringing a sandwich.

A letter has been written to Mrs. W. L. Williams, State Bird Chairman, informing her that Greenville is a Bird Sanctuary.
