Mother had be call home and you wrote me with reference to transferring to Ordnance department. I don't think I would like to change. If I had not liked this type of work I could have come home at the end of first month. However, I prefer deck service to any other and I don't want to be stuck away in an office for the duration. Hunter Marshal is evidently on the Arm guard of one of the merchant marine which is not a preferred duty. Many officers in Ordnance department are being transferred to armed guard since it requires little education in handling of ships and navigation.

Thanks for thinking about my welfare but changing is out of question for the present.
