The Society or Club. Shall be composed
of a chairman, a Secretary & corrector
who shall be elected by a majority of
the club for four weeks. and
Such members as may now associate
themselves together or may hereafter be
received.

1. The Club shall meet ~~monthly~~

by that title. He shall call the
meeting to order, preserve order and
decide among the members
decide

The Secretary shall keep a record of the proceedings. call the roll when the Ch^m takes his seat and note the absentees.

The Corrector shall be seated on the right of the Chairman and it shall be his duty to notice particularly every recitation, reading or declamation, or composition made, and correct in a respectful manner all errors or inaccuracies in Spelling, pronunciation or grammar or any other ^{ways} and to make all explanations and ~~corrections~~ any remarks on the ~~merits~~ merits of performance after his duty is performed any member of the Society may make any suggestion or correction which may appear to him or some member

The duties of the members shall be
 Composition, Reading, Declamation
 and Debates and for that purpose
 shall be divided into three Clases to be
 called first, second and third
 and at each meeting the Chairman shall
 announce the duties of each Clas for
 the next meeting. viz one Clas to
 recite Compositions, one to read some
 selected Chapter or portion of an essay
 and one to declaim, and two
 of the Clases to be announced to debate
 some query, which is to be chosen
 by the officers.

The order of business shall be
 first Compositions, 2^d Reading
 3^d Declamation, 4th Debate

The Chairman shall keep a list of each
 Clas before him, and call up in order
 each member for the duty assigned him
 He shall announce the query at the

previous meeting, the Claps that are
to discuss it on each side, or the persons
who are to open the debate, and
after each member has performed his duty
the debate shall open to all, but
no one is allowed to speak more than
twice without permission.
