To all Christian people to whom these presents shall come William Harris of Pitt County and Province of North Carolina aforesaid for and in consideration of one hundred pounds current money of this province to me in hand paid before the sealing of these presents by George Harris of the County and Province above said planter the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and myself therewith satisfied and contented have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and Deliver and convey unto him the above named George Harris his Heirs and assigns a Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Pitt and Province aforesaid on the North side of Tar River Beginning at a Seamore upon the River Running along that first line to the corner at a Stake running along the head line to a corner from that corner a straight line to an Olive upon the River then up the River to the Seamore the Beginning Tree which Land is half of Six hundred and forty Acres Granted by Patent to William Harris bearing date the second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & thirty Eight To Have and To hold the aforesaid Tract or parcel of Land together with the Houses orchards water Courses Improvements whatsoever thereon or thereunto belonging or appertaining to him the said George Harris his Heirs or assigns for his or their properties and behoove forever and the said above named William Harris do covenant promise and Grant to and with the above named George Harris that the said William Harris before the sealing of these presents am the sole and lawful owner of the above named premises and have full power to sell and Dispose of the same as above and do and shall for <sup>me</sup> my Heirs Executors Administrators him the said George Harris his Heirs or assigns shall Warrant and defend in Quiet and peaceable possession of the above named and sold premises against the Claims of all manner of persons whatsoever claiming the same and Further do covenant promise and Grant to and with the above named George Harris that I myself my Heirs or assigns shall and will ~~resist~~ and will from time to time and at all times be ready to seal sign and deliver one or more Deeds for this Land if in this or any other Given by me after this if it shall be judged necessary in Law to the said George Harris or his assigns paying yearly and every year the Lawfull Quitrents of Four Shillings for hundred Acres and the said William Harris do further Covenant promise and Grant to and with the said George Harris that the above

named and sold Premises is clear and free of all incumbrances
