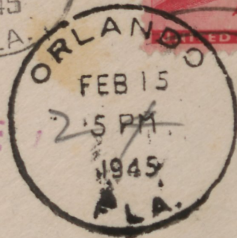
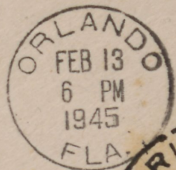
I have been meaning to write to you ever since Christmas and thank you for our gifts. As you know, bath powder is always welcome and the children were thrilled with their money.

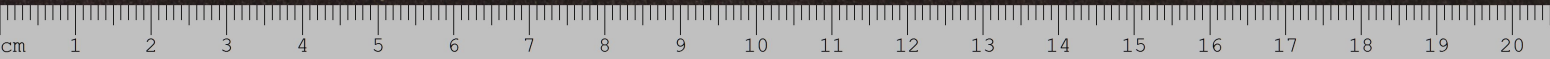
