 6. Clean all fuel oil vents on top-side.

- 0600 - Reveille.
- 0630 - "Up all bunks."
- 0700 - Breakfast.
- 0730 - Put # 1 and 2 M.W.B. in Water.
- 0800 - (a) MORNING COLORS - Foreign National Anthem if ships of other navies present.
(b) "Turn To. Clean up all berthing and messing compartments and passageways. Wash down weather decks and carry out Special Instructions; empty all trash cans. Make final preparations for Captain's Inspection at 0900."
(c) # 2 M.W.B. alongside for Lieut. Fleming.
- 0855 - OFFICERS' CALL.
- 0900 - QUARTERS FOR MUSTER, followed by Captain's Inspection of Personnel. (Attention is directed to Chapter 740 Ship's Regulations, re Spaces to be Inspected). Uniform for Inspection is:
OFFICERS: Service Dress Blue "B", with gloves.
C.P.O.'s: Dress Blue "B".
ENLISTED MEN: Dress Blue "B".
- WHEN DIRECTED - Compartment Cleaners, Storeroom Keepers, Hammock Stowers, fall out, open up, and stand by their stations for Inspection.
- 1145 - Dinner.
- 1215 - Land Shore Patrol.
- 1245 - LIBERTY for 1st Section - to expire at the Landing at 1800, C.P.O.'s 2000.
- 1300 - "Turn To. Sweep down all decks and ladders. Continue Ship's Work and carry out Special Instructions; empty all trash cans
- 1400 - Movies in the Hangar.
- 1500 - "Sweep down all decks and ladders."
- 1700 - Supper.
- 1900 - INSPECTION CALL. "Compartment Cleaners and Duty P.O.'s stand by living and messing spaces for Inspection by C & R Duty Officer."
- 1930 - HAMMOCKS.
- 2000 - Movies in wardroom.
