Fever Remedies

Accurite: In inflammatory conditions. Full bounding pulse, great heat, Tossing about, very thirsty, nervous, pain, and frequently, if a child it will bite its hands.

Belladonna: Face flushed, pupils frequently dilated. Drowsy, sleepy state, and often starting and jumping while asleep. Well suited to precocious children with light-hair and blue eyes.

Gelsemium: Patient usually wants to lie still at rest. High fever, not much thirst, skin moist and hot, and frustration.

Ferrum Phosphoricum: Onset not so sudden. Fever and pain not so severe.

Veratrum Viride: High fever attended by nausea and vomiting, cold sweat, Affections of the brain, and frequently convulsions.
