You will understand that nothing can be done regarding money matters until the will has been admitted to probate and in order to facilitate matters in that direction I have sent you a paper to be signed waiving the service of citation on the proving of the will.

It should be signed opposite the seal before a Notary Public or some person authorized by the laws of Tennessee to take acknowledgments of Deeds. Then you must take it to the County Clerk for his signature & to have the seal of the County attached.
