


## Wills 1663 - 1722

my wife MARGIT LARANCE. Daughter RACHEL LARANCE - cows; land after the decease of my wife. Cousin RACHEL SNELLING - cow & calf. Cousin WILLIAM LARANCE - cow & calfe. Wife MARGIT LARANCE - house & plantation. Other legacies.

brother ISRAEL SNELLING, JOHN LARANCE Ex.

31 Jul 1693(before Edward Moor) 303. PAUL LATHUM 7 Oct 1692 0 Of Albemarle Co. "sick & weak of body"

Wife ELIZABETH LATHUM - negro man Seneca(?); plantation where I now live during her life; ½ my estate. Son GEORGE LATHUM - plantation where I now live after his mother's death; should he die a minor then to my daughter ELIZABETH LATHUM; should she die a minor then to AUGUSTIN the son of JNO. WRIGHT minister.

11 Jul 1704(before Thos. Snoden) 3 Aug 1701 O 304. WM.(x)LATTY [Note: Much of this will is torn away.]

Daughter BARBERY SEAGUE - yearlings. Granddaughtrer MARY LUTTY - cows. Daughter-in-law MARY LATTY - heifer. Son WILLIAM LATTY - cattle, lands & WILLIAM LATTY should have sd land after the decease of his father WILLIAM LATTY JR., but he should have no son then to BARBERRY LATTY & MARY LATTY the daughter of WILLIAM LATTY.

## 305. JOHN LAWSON gent. 875/39 & 98 (no probate) 12 Aug 1708 Of Bath Co.

"Dearly beloved" HANNAH SMITH - the house I now live in during her life, 3/3 my personal estate in North Carolina. My daughter ISABELLA of Bath Co., & the brother & sister which her mother HANNAH SMITH is with child & "then Every Childe of hers by me" - rest of my estate, when they arrive to age 21 or marry. HANNAH SMITH, the Commissioners of the Court of Bath Co. Ex. WILLIAM(x)HANCOCKE, RICHD. SMITH, JAMES LEIGH Wit. [Note: The copy on p. 98 says Isabella of Bath Town.]

306. JOHN LEAR 21 Nov 1695 O 12 Dec 1695(before Andrew Ross) Of Nansemond Co. Virginia. "weake in body" WIDOW PITT my sister - what she owes me. WIDOW PARDUE of Isle of Wight Co. - 100£. Daughters MARTHA BURWELL & ELIZABETH LEAR the widow of my dec'd son THOMAS LEAR - certain personal items. Granddaughter ELIZABETH LEAR - 250 acres in Narrakyquirk(?) Bay which I leased to JAMES GODWIN now in possession of Capt. ROBT. RANDALL for her life & if she has no heir then to JOHN GEORGE or to my grandson JOHN LEAR. CHARLES GOREMGE - 330 acres in Surry Co. which I was about to sell to WILLIAM BROWN; negro boy Charles at Corotan, negro girl Nanny. JOHN GEORGE - negroes Jark, Dido & wife. JAMES MOUNTGOMERE - suit of clothes. Other legacies, including property in England. Mentioned were daughter MARTHA BURWELL & the children she had by COL. COLE; land bought from GEORGE WILLIAMS, the plantation where MATHEW ADAMS(?) did live. son-in- Majr. LEWIS BURWELL, friend Capt. THOAMS GODWIN Ex. WILLIAM(x)COFFEILD, ELIZABETH BRIDGER, ANN(x)COFFEILD Wit.
