





Records of Regiment No. 12. M. V. M.

The following notice was promulgated in The Boston Evening Journal of April 20. 1861.

" Fellow Citizens - I have been assured by the
" Executive Department that the State will accept
" at once an additional Regiment of Infantry.

" I therefore propose to meet tomorrow
" at 10 o'clock in front of the Merchants Exchange,
" State Street, such of my fellow-citizens as will
" join in raising this new Regiment.

" The muster roll will be ready to be
" signed then and there.

In accordance with the above call Mr. Webster addressed a dense throng, assembled at the appointed hour, announcing his purpose.

Messrs William Dehou, Charles Levi Woodbury and others also made some stirring remarks.

During the afternoon Capt. Alex. Hickborn arrived from North Bridgewater and tendered a full Company to the Webster Regiment.

Assurances were given that Plymouth County alone would fill the Ranks in five days if desired.

The proprietors of the Merchants Exchange tendered Mr. Webster the rooms recently occupied as the Post Office, and he appointed them his Head Quarters.
