my dear Mary B - many, many  
thanks for the chocolate which  
reached me on Christmas Eve.  
It was certainly a great treat for  
there is no cacao here and the  
people say it has been 3 years  
since they have seen cocoa or  
chocolate in any form.

After a very pleasant  
stay of 10 days here we are ordered  
to move Dec 30th. We are going  
back to Compiègne, France and  
that is as far as we know now.  
Whether it means that we

are now on our eventual  
way ~~home~~ or shall again be  
sent thru this country and  
into Germany - "Sais Pas". Either  
may happen.

I am enclosing a  
letter that you forwarded home  
but which evidently belongs to  
someone else. I think that something  
ought to be done about it but  
please suit yourself about the  
letter. If you do not wish to  
give it to anyone, we will wait  
until I get back and I will try  
to do something about it.

Please write to me as often  
as you can.
