REGULATIONS

- 1. The gates will be opened for admission to the public at 9 o'clock A. M. each day with the exception of Monday when the gates will open at 4:00 o'clock.
- 2. All the employees of the fair, must be phomptly on hand at their post at 9 o'clock A. M., each day of the fair, and remain on duty until close of fair.
- 3. Every reasonable effort will be made by the officers of the Association and those in charge of the grounds to protect the property of exhibitors from loss or damage. But the Association will not be held responsible should loss or damage occur.
- 4. Drunkeness, quarreling or the use of profane or indecent language will not be allowed on the grounds, nor the presence of fireworks, petroleum, gun-powder or any other dangerous or objectional material whatever.
- 5. No peddling, hawking or selling of any kind will be allowed in the buildings or on the grounds except by a special license obtained from the Secretary of the Association.
- 6. The distribution of hand bills or other advertisements is strictly prohibited about the grounds or buildings, except under directions of the manager.
- 7. No entries will be entitled to a space until the proper entry has been made. After an article has been entered for a premium it cannot be removed until 1:00 o'clock, Saturday, October 31. If any person removes an article before then, he forfeits all claim to a premium, even if the same shall have been awarded.
- 8. All exhibits must be in place and ready for inspection by 5:00 o'clock Tuesday, October 22, 1936.
 - 9. No disorderly conduct of any kind will be allowed.
- 10. All privilege and concession people, together with their employees, assistants and helpers, must obey the rules of any special regulation of the association, and any neglect or refusal to do so will forfeit any rights they may have had by virtue of such privilege and concessions.
