THIS INDENTURE, made this *26th* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred *twenty nine* between *Henry Alexander* Sheriff of *Lynne* County and State of North Carolina, of the one part, and *Joseph White* of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that whereas by virtue of *Wende Exponas* issued by the Clerk of the County Court of *Lynne* & ducte to the Sheriff of said County & tested the *27* of May 1827 at the instance of *Josiah Sawyer* against *Timothy Jones* for the sum of twenty two dollars $\$43$ Judgment Int & cost

aforesaid, directed to the Sheriff of *Lynne* County against the goods and chattels lands and tenements of *Timothy Jones* returnable on the *fourth* Monday in *July* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *twenty seven* to the said Court. And whereas, I, the said *Henry Alexander* Sheriff as aforesaid, did by virtue thereof, enter upon and levy the aforesaid *execution* upon a certain piece, tract or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, butted and bounded as follows—Beginning *at a Lightwood post at the corner of Jos White's fence, then along the road ~~to the~~ North 18 pole, then N 70 W 60 pole, then S 35 E 70 pole then N 63 E 18 to the first station containing seven acres & then quarters more or less*—
being the property of the said *Timothy Jones* her for want of goods and chattels, and did duly advertise and expose the same at Public Sale *at the Court House* to the highest bidder, to satisfy and pay the aforesaid *sum* of *twenty two dollars* $\$43$ on the *23* day of *July* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & *27* When and where the aforesaid *Joseph White* of the second

party *personally* appeared and bid for the said land *twenty two dollars* $\$12$ ~~per acre~~ and that being the highest and last bid become the purchaser thereof.

NOW THIS INDENTURE further witnesseth that for and in consideration of the aforesaid sum of $\$22.12$ ~~per acre~~ to me the said *Henry Alexander* Sheriff as aforesaid, by the said *Joseph White* her paid in satisfaction for the said purchase of land. I, the said *Henry Alexander* Sheriff as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Act of Assembly in such cases provided, doth hereby bargain, sell and convey unto the said *Joseph White* her heirs and assigns the aforesaid tract of land, situated in the County of *Lynne* and bounded as above:

To have and to hold the aforesaid land to the only proper use and behalf of *him* the said *Joseph White* her heirs and assigns forever. And I the said *Henry Alexander* Sheriff as aforesaid, doth hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, warrant and forever defend the right, title and interest to the said land unto the said *Joseph White* her heirs and assigns, against the claim of all persons whomsoever so far *only* as I am bound by law as Sheriff of the County of *Lynne* but no further.
