 Tyrrell County } So all to whom these presents shall come

Greeting

Know ye that I Roger Brickhouse of the County and State aforesaid for the full and just sum of \$15⁰⁰ to me in hand paid by Bartlett Jones the receipt I do acknowledge myself satisfied have granted bargained and sold — and conveyed and confirmed unto him the said Bartlett Jones a certain piece or parcel of land containing 7 Ten Acres the one half of the tract of land whereon I live except one acre more or less after my death which I exempt my life-time and then to him the said Bartlett Jones which the ten acres is to be with the west end of the plantation Beginning at the Lightwood post standing in woods patent line running from thence South and cross to a Great persimmon tree William Whites corner thence East so as to forme — to certain Ten Acres I have and to Hold the said Land and premises with all the appurtenances and commodities of or in any wise appertaining there unto him the said Bartlett Jones his heirs and Executors Admors - and assigns forever against the lawful claim of me my heirs and assigns, Admors - and Executors - In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal the 9th day of January 1819 -

Tyrrell County January Term of Court 1820. This deed of sale of land from Roger Brickhouse to Bartlett Jones was duly proved in open court by the oath of Joseph White and ordered to be registered.

Roger Poole Jones Brickhouse was the mother of this second Bartlett Jones who was known as Bartlett Jones Sr. He is the one who married Angelica White - daughter of Joseph White who was one of the witnesses for the above deed.

David Jones of Tyrrell County sold to "my son Bartlett Jones" 50 acres of land on the West side of Alligator River for the sum of "fifty-five Barilla of Indian Corn." 7th day of February 1793.
