The Petition of Hezekiah Brickhouse and
Hager his wife humbly complaining sheweth unto your worship
That Bartlett Jones died Intestate sometime
in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight
Leaving your Petitioner Hager his widow who has
since intermarried with Hezekiah Brickhouse and seized
and possessed of several tracts of land in the County
aforesaid to wit one tract whereon he lived containing
about 100 acres one other tract containing about 50 acres
a part of the Manner plantation whereon John Poole
formerly lived one other tract adjoining the land of Ben-
jamin Baker sen: dnt: containing about 100 acres one
other tract on the West side of Allegator River containing
about 50 acres one other tract lying on Daniel Jones line
containing about 37 acres also one other tract of Swamp
containing about 100 acres in all which said tracts
your Petitioner wife Hager at the decease of the D: Bartlett
Jones became entitled to her dower now for as much as
no dower has ever yet been assigned or laid off to the
D: Hager your Petitioner prays that a Jury of Good
and Lawfull men may be ordered on the premises
aforesaid and lay off her dower according to the law
in such case provided and your Petitioner as in duty
bound shall ever pray &c Jas B Shennor att.
