That Bartlett Jones late of the County aforesaid departed
this life on or about the ... day of ... in the year of
our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety eight (3)
that he died intestate, leaving issue the said Ollender
Thomas, Mary, Barnaby, Elizabeth, Timothy and Bartlett,
that he died seized of a considerable real estate, viz,
~~two~~ tract of Swamp on the east side of Great Allica-
tor River adjoining lands of John Gray Blount -
two other tract of land lying on the west side of said
River adjoining David Jones' Land - one other tract
of land lying on the west side of said River, adjoining
Justus Liverman's Land - ~~and~~ one other tract of land
lying on the west side of said River adjoining land
of Isaac Meekins and one other tract of land lying on
the west side of said River adjoining James Pohoons Land
And whereas the heirs of the said Intestate are
entitled by Law to an equal share of his estate and
your Petitioners the said Heirs are willing and desirous
to have the said lands divided and set off agree-
ably to law in severalty under the act of the Legislature

which division and allotment cannot be done or com-
pleted without the Order of this Worshippfull Court,
by reason of the Infancy of your Petitioners -

May it please your Worships to order the Sur-
geon of the County and five honest freeholders, to wit,
Capt John Bateman, Thomas Liverman Esquire,
John Clayton, Joseph White and William Liverman
son of William, to make division of the real estate
of the said Bartlett Jones according to the act of as-
sembly in such case made and provided and to give
your Petitioners such other and farther relief as in your
justice & wisdom may seem meet & Your Petition-
ers as in duty bound will ever pray &c
