Jones late of the State and County aforesaid did on the

of his death he was seised and possessed of a considerable
Personal property that Bager Jones widow & Relict of the
S^d Bartlett there father did administer on the Estate of the
S^d father and afterwards intermarried with one Elizabeth
Brickhouse who thereby became administrator of there said
father and took upon himself the ^{burden} ~~burden~~ of the said admi-
-nistration they further state that some time in the ^{year} 1802
application was made to your worships by these respective Guar-
-dians to get the Estate of S^d deceased father settled over

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with the said Hyskiah Brickhouse administrator as aforesaid

your petitioners are remediless in the premises only by this
mode of application to your worshipful Court May it
Please your worships to grant your petitioners their writ
of subpoena ordering the D adm^r personally to appear
before the Justices of this worshipful Court on the 4th
over

fourth Monday of July Next then and there to answer on
his Corporal oath to all and singular the allegations contained
in your petitioners bill of Complaint &c &c to pay to your
Petitioners the several balances adjudged to them and give
your petitioners such other and further relief as in your
Justice and wisdom shall seem meet & Equitable &c and
your petitioners as in duty bound will &c
