


State of N.C. Carolina, Whence Battit Jones has this day produced
Yancey County — Vouches to us the receipt in the following
form. Recd^d of Battit Jones one dollar 25/100 in full
for the Tax of the Jones here entituled by Isd^d White & sold
to satisfy s^d Tax for 1835, for which we are to give a deed
July 24th 1835 — signed Isd^d Alexander whence the s^d Battit
Jones has also presented to us the annex^d plat of s^d land
now known all men by these presents that we Isd^d Alexander
& H. G. Spruill Secundus of George & Alexander Esqrs of
Yancey County after having duly advertised s^d land &
sold it for the Tax due the year 1835 before the Comt
lawman doot in Columbia on the 24th July 1835 as
bargain & sold to the s^d Battit Jones Eight acres of
land lying in the County afores^d & in Gum Neck —
Beginning at a Battit Jones corner running S. 32. poles
to his other corner then E. 40. poles to a dogwood tree Whites
corner then S. 32. poles then W. 40. poles to the first station &
we do warrant & defend the title of s^d land to the
s^d Battit Jones as far as we are authorized to do
as Secundus afores^d but no further Given under our
hands & seals this 23rd Oct. 1838.
