wright and title in a certior piece or parcel  
of land situated and lying in the county of  
afore said and in gumnick name by the  
six hundred acre portion and granted from  
the state to Jones & pool to have and to the  
said land free and clear from all incumbran-  
ments whatsoever and further more I the said  
silverman Armstrong and ally armstrong  
his wife do for ever warrant and defend the  
said title in witness whereof I have here-  
unto set my hand and seal this the 15<sup>th</sup> day  
of December 1835.
