for and in Consideration of the sum of fifty Shillings for Every hundred
acres hereby Granted paid into our Treasury by William Cohoon & William
Ransham have Given & Granted & by these presents do Give & Grant
unto the Said William Cohoon & William Ransham a Tract of Land Contain-
-ing three hundred and fifty five acres lying & being in our County
of Tyrrell on the west side of Great Alligator River Beginning at
a Poplar & Hickory Standing on the ash Branch then North Ten
Degrees west four hundred poles along bearing line to a Gum then
East one hundred & eighty poles then South three hundred & ninety
poles then South eighty eight Degrees west one hundred & ten poles
To the first Station as by the plat hereunto Annexed doth appear
Together with all woods waters mines Minerals Hereditaments &
appurtenances to the Said Land belonging or appertaining
To Hold to the Said William Cohoon & William Ransham his
heirs & assigns for ever Yielding & paying to us such sums
of money Yearly or Otherwise as our General Assembly
from Time to Time may Direct Provided always that the
Said William Cohoon & William Ransham shall Cause this
Grant to be Registered in the Registers Office of our Said County
of Tyrrell within Twelve Months from the Date hereof
otherwise the Same shall be void & of no Effect, In Testimony
whereof we have caused these Our letters to be made patent
and Our Great Seal to be hereunto affixed Witness Richard
Casewell Esquire our Governor Captain General & Commander
in Chief at Kingston the Twenty second Day of August in the Eleventh
Year of our Independance and in the Year of our Lord one thousand
