appertaining thereunto unto him the S. Bartlett Jones. he his heirs Ex.
administrators or assigns, and do warrant Secure and defend the S. land
and premises against the Lawfull Claims of Me my heirs Ex. ad.
for Ever unto the S. Bartlett Jones he his heirs Ex. ad. and assigns
in Witnes thereof I have Hereunto set my Hand and Seal this
Seventh day of february in the year of our Lord God one Thousand
Seven Hundred Ninety and Three
