for the consideration of the sume of fifty one Dollars to me
in hand paid the Receipt wherean with I am fully satisfied
And paid and contented have Bargained and cōfirmed and
cōfirmed unto him the s^r. Bartlet Jones a certain part
of Land being Eight and one hafē across it Being one
Seventh part of the Plantation where on my brother
Bartlet Jones Senior formerly lived on the Patrall Baring
Date 1st day of March 1780 N^o 69 Called Cummings Garden
on the North side of Joseph Woods line begining at a ligh
wood post thence East along Woods line one hundred and
Forty pole to a Gum tree corner thence North bending on yron
Pann sevemcupt two hundred and twenty pole to a pine
thence South Seventy five Degrees West three hundred and
Forty pole thence South Eighty pole to John Gibson line

thence along Gibson line East one hundred and Eighty pole
to two Lorrals his corner thence South fifty pole to the
First Station To have and to hold the above Bargained
Land and premises with all the appertaininge there unto
Belonging unto him the s^r. Bartlet Jones or his Spouse or heirs
or Administrator for ever I the s^r. Timothy Jones Senior do

Warrant and defend and secure from me my heirs and
Spouse or Exec^r or Executor and from the Lawfull Claine or
Claines of any person or persons in witness my hand and
