confirmed unto him the s^c. Bartlett Jones a certain part
of Land being Eight and one half acres it Being one
Seventh part of of the plantation whereon my Brother
Bartlett Jones Senex formerly lived on the Patent Baring
Date 1st day of March 1780 N^o 69 Called Cumming Garden
on the North side of Joseph Woods line beginning at a Ligh
wood post thence East along woods line one hundred and
Forty pole to a Gum his Corner thence North bending on frozen
Pann sevenumpt two hundred and twenty pole to a pine
thence South Seventy five Degrees West three hundred and
Forty pole thence South Eighty pole to John Gibson line
thence along Gibson line East one hundred and Eighty pole
to two Corrals his Corner thence South fifty pole to the
First Station To have and to hold the above Bargned
Land and premises with all the appertainence there unto
Belanging unto him the s^c. Bartlett Jones or his Heirs or heirs
or Administrator for Ever I the s^c. Timothy Jones Senex do
Warrant and Defend and Secure from me my heirs and
Heirs or Heirs or Executors and from the Lawful Claim or
Claims of any person or persons in witness my hand and
Seale this 22nd day of November 1828.
