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I would like to reserve a saving clause.

Well, this is the position taken by this 5% of the --- what I would call the activists and it is right interesting to note that in the school discussions at Chapel Hill last week that the student body president of A.&T. University appeared on the platform at the program and recalled that he was one of those who had requested the federal investigation and made some other serious charges and in his presentation he talked about two student involvements. He did not put the limitations on it that I put on mine today reserving final authority but in the question and answer period he was asked what the students would do to improve the educational process if they were given this authority and after considerable thought, he gave a right intelligent answer and he went back to say that the faculty and administration was experienced and that in the final analysis that they had to depend upon their experience and their greater insight into the problems and really all that they were asking was, of course, to be heard. Well, this is not what they are saying but when you pin them down this is really about all they are asking for and the 95% of the students I think this is all they want.

No one ever likes to admit that somebody else wrote a part of their speech but if I can say this off the record I would like to say to you that the two pages that I read on student involvement was written by a legal intern in my office yesterday after he and I had had some discussion ~~and~~ about our ideas and I had told him what we did at East Carolina ~~in~~ about-in regard to the students and I didn't ask him what to write but quite frankly I didn't have time to put it all together ~~tonight~~ *Friday* so I thought I would call on everybody I could yesterday and the two pages was written by Ken Spalding who is a third-year law student at the University of North Carolina and I might say that he ~~is~~ also the only Negro law student at the University and the only Negro to ever work in the Attorney General's office in Raleigh and these words that I have read to you about reserving the right and authority were his and not mine. The only part that I discussed with him about was involvement of the students and asked him to give me his thoughts and his ideas and I read those two pages to you verbatim

so I think that reflects what the student body is thinking.
