PRESENTATION BY ATTORNEY GENERAL ROBERT MORGAN OF
ASSOCIATE JUSTICE-DESIGNATE DANIEL KILLIAN MOORE TO
THE NORTH CAROLINA SUPREME COURT - December 1, 1969

May it please the Court. A position as Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of North Carolina has become vacant, and His Excellency, the Governor of North Carolina, has appointed the Honorable Daniel Killian Moore to fill that vacancy. It is my honor to have and to present to the Court the Commission duly signed by the Governor, attested by the Secretary of State, and impressed with the Great Seal of the State of North Carolina, appointing the Honorable Daniel Killian Moore Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of North Carolina for a term expiring January 1, 1971, pursuant to Article IV, Section 17 of the Constitution of North Carolina. The Associate Justice-designate is present and is prepared to take the oaths prescribed by law.
