STATEMENT BY ATTORNEY GENERAL ROBERT MORGAN

When we called you about this press conference today, we told you we would make no major announcements but would talk with you generally about our campaign for re-election. That's what I'm going to do and, of course, I'll be glad to answer any questions you might have.

As you know, we are using the campaign slogan, "He keeps his promises." We feel we can do so in complete candor because we have kept the promises we made to the people of North Carolina four years ago when we ran for the Office of Attorney General.

We came into office just as the drug crisis really began to be felt in North Carolina. Though I know as well as you do that better/<sup>law</sup>enforcement is not the only answer to solving the problem of drug abuse, it is an important part of the answer. So we went to work to improve the ability of the State Bureau of Investigation to cope with the problem.
