SESSIONS WILL NOW BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. I WAS PLEASED TO
JOIN HIM IN SUPPORT OF THESE RULE CHANGES AND BELIEVE AS
HE DOES THAT THEY WILL HELP GIVE THE FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE
PROCESS MORE CREDIBILITY AND INSURE THAT ACTION TAKEN IN
FACT WILL BE IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST.

I ADMIRE THE KIND OF CANDOR AND OPENESS THAT

LAWTON CHILES HAS COME TO STAND FOR. FOUR YEARS FROM

HIS ELECTION HE STILL IS CLOSE TO THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE

AND IS VERY MUCH "THE PEOPLE'S SENATOR."

HE INTENDS TO KEEP IT THAT WAY AND THAT IS THE
REASON HE HAS KEPT HIS ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF IN THE STATE
