

Grant to Ambrose Burr for 100 acres land th Aug 1786.
In the County of Sevier on the North side of Swift
creek and West side of Calmets swamp beginning
at a small pine in Charles Roachs line running
then South fifty seven degrees East to Herringtons cor-
ner and with his line thirty three poles to a light wood
stake centred by a black jack in Kings line of Pryans
patent then with the same South thirty eight degrees
West one hundred and twenty eight poles to three black
jacks said Kings corner then South sixty seven degrees West
eighty poles to a pine on the South side of Long branch
then North thirty four degrees West eighty poles to a stake
centred between two pines on a small branch or drain
that makes out of Long branch then with a direct line
to the beginning.
