that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred
and seventy five pounds to us in hand paid by W^m Hardy
the receipt whereof we acknowledge ourselves fully sa-
tisfied contented and paid have given granted bargained
and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain
and sell unto the s^t W^m Hardy a certain tract or parcel
of land lying in the County of Craven and North side of
Neuse river, beginning at a poplar near John Harts line
and runs N. 32 W. 120 poles to a red oak then S. 38 W. 240
poles to a white oak on a branch then S. 32 E. 120 poles
down the branch to a dogwood then up the Bermeto
swamp to the beginning containing two hundred acres
be the same more or less, also another piece or parcel of
land granted to Jeremiah King, beginning at a pine
Richard Harts beginning corner thence with his given
line N. 45 E. 41 poles to a stake then S. 26 E. to the run
of Bermeto swamp then down the run of s^t swamp to
Johnsons line and with the same to the said poplar the
beginning of the above tract of land then a direct line
to the first station containing by estimation eighty acres
the aforesaid land being Thomas Kings part of a share of
his father Jeremiah Kings land on Bermeto swamp, To
have and to hold the above bargained premises to the s^t
W^m Hardy his heirs and assigns forever and we bind
ourselves our heirs and assigns to warrant and defend
the said premises against the lawful claim or claims
of any person or persons whatever.
