


This Indenture made on the Tenth day of February  
A D One thousand Eight hundred and forty seven  
(1847) between David Clark of the County of Rutherford of the  
one part, and William H Butler of the County of  
Crawford both of the State of North Carolina  
Witneseth That the said David Clark for and  
in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars  
to him in hand paid by the said W H Butler, at the  
time of executing these presents the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold  
aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth  
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said William  
H Butler his heirs and assigns a certain piece or parcel  
of land in the County of Crawford and State of North Carolina  
lying between and adjoining the lands of James Roach -  
Alexander Ellison John Clark John Hardy William Gaston  
and Edward Chapman, lands containing one hun-  
dred acres more or less To have and to hold the said  
land and premises and all and singular the tenements  
hereditaments woods ways mines minerals improvements  
rights uses profits revenues reversions privileges  
and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any  
wise appertaining to him the said W H Butler,  
his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper use  
and behoof in fee simple forever. And the said  
David Clark his heirs and assigns all and singular  
the premises hereby conveyed to the said William  
H Butler his heirs and assigns shall and well warrant  
and forever defend from the lawful claim or  
claims of all persons whatsoever
