No. 225. Know ye that we have granted unto Charles Roach  
thirty six acres of land in Craven County, North,  
of Swifts Creek and West side of Permeto Swamp  
Beginning at a black gum in the run of the Long  
Branch by old Nashes old cart path, running  
thence South sixty seven degrees West thirty two  
poles and seven links to a pine supposed to  
be in or near Blount's land, thence South  
forty three degrees East one hundred and  
twelve pole and six links to a stake centred  
between two small pines Ambrose Bull's  
corner, thence with Bull's given line North  
forty six degrees East one hundred and six-  
ty six pole to Bull's beginning corner a  
small pine, thence South sixty four degrees  
West with his other patent line to the Long  
Branch and up the several courses of the  
Long Branch to the first place of Begin-  
ning. To Hold to the said Charles Roach  
his heirs and assigns forever Dated the  
9<sup>th</sup> day of August 1786.
