Under the act to provide an Invalid Corps
approved February 17th 1864

To all whom it may concern
Know ye that Charles C. Butler a private of
Captain J. R. Roaches Company D of the 44th
Regiment of N. C. Troops who was enlisted the
10th day of May one thousand eight hundred and
sixty two to serve three years or the war is hereby
honorably retired from military service with the
pay and emolument of a private in the Army
of the Confederate States

Said Soldier was born in the County
of Craven in the State of North Carolina
is twenty years of age five feet and eight inches
high dark complexion dark eyes dark hair
and by occupation when enlisted a farmer
