The only problem has always been the adhesive directly applied to the hair, scalp and skin, which proposes a serious problem. Because of this a lot of professional

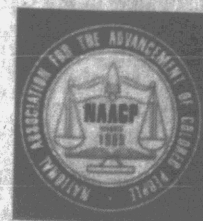

# Eight Annual Native American Rodeo and Pow WoW

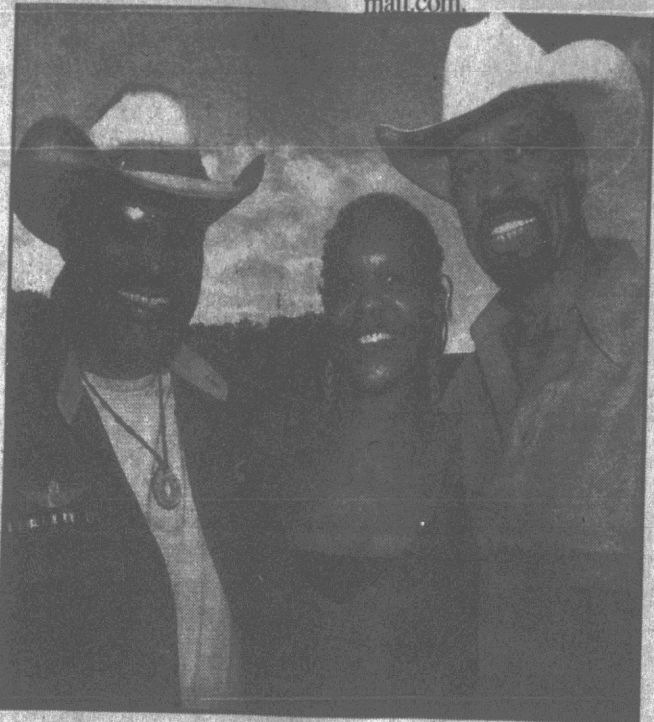
Rich Washington, president of Rodeo Rich Productions, and Exec. of WOOW Radio in Greenville

## J.H. Rose's JaQuan Waller Remembered

700 people attended the memorial for J.H. Rose's JaQuan Waller. J.H. Rose High School coach Todd Lipe said in a release that the junior running back was a dedicated player who was well liked by his teammates. Waller collapsed Friday Night (9/19) on the sideline after he was hit at the line of scrimmage and fumbled. He was taken from the game in an ambulance. Nearly 700 J.H. Rose High School students, faculty members and others from the community joined the family of JaQuan Waller on Wednesday at the school to honor the player who died following a football game last weekend.

Some wore signs or shirts they designed honoring the 16-year-old known as "350" to some and "Quan" to others. They shed tears and shared laughter as Waller's friends,

teammates and school administrators reflected on their experiences with him. "He was the kind of student who reminds me why I do what I do," said J.H. Rose Assistant Principal Lettie McPhail during the ceremony. Waller was remembered Wednesday as a funny, athletic kid who was on pace to graduate with his class. Brad Williams, one of his Rampant teammates, said the junior provided highlights on and off of the field.



A viewing for Waller will be held at 6 p.m. on Friday night at the Salvation and Praise Church in Farmville. Funeral services are set for Saturday at 2 p.m. at the Koinonia Christian Church in Greenville.

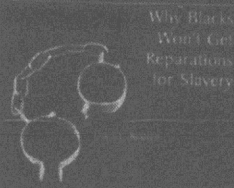

This book, *One Hundred One Reasons Why Blacks Won't Get Reparations for Slavery*, provides from a black perspective one hundred one reasons why White America is against reparations for slavery. The reasons given begin with whites being vehemently against reparations and terminating with an opposite stance laced with numerous caveats. These caveats seem to diminish the generous spirit of contemporary whites who fail to have the will and determination to do right by the descendants of slaves.

Instead of discussing reparations in good faith and compromising on a favorable solution, whites denigrate blacks and their contributions to America's political, social, and economic development. Blacks' rebuttal to several of the arguments put forth is scanty and not very thoughtful. To them, reparations for slavery require action instead of debates.

The book is a compilation of ideas taken from discussions on reparations over a twenty-year period. The discussions were held mostly among small groups of black thinkers who recollected continuous dealings with white Americans. These thinkers' perspectives on reparations and their views of whites on the subject is revealing and enlightening.
