DRUNKEN DRIVERS MUST GO

On the heels of two fatal accidents reported to have been caused by drunken drivers, the following editorial from the News and Observer is indeed timely.

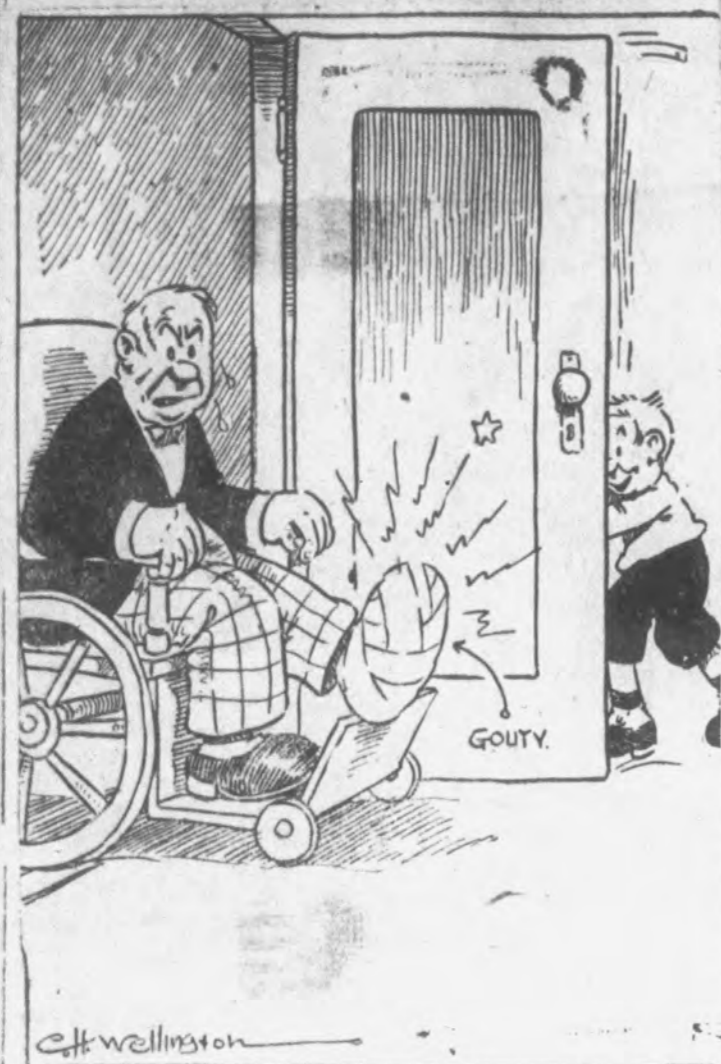
Under the heading, "Drunken Drivers Outlawed," the Observer says: "Drunken drivers of automobiles were outlawed by the last Legislature, which made it mandatory upon courts to deny the right to drive a car for a period of not less than 90 days to any persons convicted of driving while intoxicated.

"Public sentiment is divided on many things, but not on this question. Nothing is so fixed in the public mind as the feeling that drunken drivers of automobiles cannot be tolerated. Not only are they a menace to themselves but they are also a menace to every other automobile passenger as well as to any pedestrian who ventures on the highway.

"Drunken drivers of locomotives and intoxicated motormen were outlawed before the days of prohibition, and no statute has been more effectively enforced than that one. No man with the smell of liquor on his breath is permitted to take a locomotive out of the round house. Yet the locomotive has a track upon which to run, and cannot go wild as can an automobile.

"The history of legislation relative to drunken drivers of automobiles for the last ten years has been a gradual tightening of the restrictions. The 1927 Legislature made the statute stricter than ever before. The law as it now stands on the books, follows: "Any person who shall, while intoxicated or under

the influence of intoxicating liquors or bitters, morphine or other opiates, operate a motor vehicle upon any public highway or cartway or other road, over which the public has a right to travel, of any county or the streets of any city or town in this State, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not less than \$50 or imprisoned not less than 30 days, or both at the discretion of the court, and the judge shall, upon conviction, deny said person or persons the right to drive a motor vehicle on any of the roads defined in this act for a period of not more than 12 months nor less than 90 days."
