

Ad Hoc Committee for Consideration of
Graduate Curricula and Advisors

An ad hoc committee was established at the last graduate faculty meeting (October 20, 1969) and instructed (1) to prepare an up-to-date check sheet for the Clinical and General Theoretical graduate programs and (2) to make recommendations concerning the appointment of graduate advisors.

I. Concerning the check sheet and related matters, the committee recommends the following:

A. That the check sheet presented on page 3 be adopted by the Graduate Faculty. The check sheet on page 3 entails the following recommendations:

1. For Core Curriculum: That the required core courses be changed from

b. That Psychological Assessment I-484, Psychological Assessment II-485, and Psychological Assessment III-486 be limited to clinical majors.

c. That clinical majors be required to take a 3-hour psychology elective.

B. That Theory and Systems-481 be changed to a senior-graduate elective.

C. That the General Theoretical Program adopt a pre-doctoral orientation.

D. That the General Theoretical Program be retitled General Experimental Program.

II. Concerning graduate advisors, the committee recommends the following:

A. That the departmental chairman serve as academic advisor for each new student in the General Theoretical Program until a thesis chairman is appointed for the student, after which the thesis chairman serve as academic advisor for the student.

B. That the graduate clinical faculty be permitted to deliberate further before making a recommendation.
