

This Indenture made the third day of June in the year of Our Lord
One thousand seven hundred and Sixty seven between William
Maget of the County of Southampton and State of N. Carolina of the One
part and Shadrach Futrell of the County and State aforesaid of the Other part
witnesseth that the S. William Maget for and in consideration of
the sum of One hundred silver dollars to him in hand paid by
the Shadrach Futrell a part whereof is hereby acknowledged and have by
these presents bargained sold and confirmed unto the S. Shadrach-
Futrell his Heirs and Assigns forever a certain Tract or dividend of
land Situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation
One hundred Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
(SO BEING) beginning at a pine in the S. William Magets line running
N. 82 Degrees East 204 pole to a corner white Oak & Lightwood Stump
in William Manns line then S. 67 pole to the S. William Manns
corner Red Oak then S. 72 Degs West 74 pole to a corner Red Oak
then S. 20 Degs East 43 pole to a corner Lightwood Stump James Sher-
rods corner then N. 80 Degs West 137 pole to a post Oak in the S. James-
Sharrods line then along the side path N. 14 Degs West 70 pole to the
S. William Magets line cornering at a Red Oak then N. 24 East
10 pole to the first station with the appertanences there unto belonging
to him the S. Shadrach Futrell his Heirs and Assigns for ever SO BEING
& SO BEING the S. parcel of land with all and singular the appertane-
nces thereunto belonging to him the S. Shadrach Futrell as aforesaid and
the S. William Maget doth for my self my Heirs Ex. &c. Covenant and
agree to and with the S. Shadrach Futrell his Heirs and Assigns that he
will defend the S. bargained land and primises and every part and par-
cel thereof from the just Claim and demand of all and all manner of
person and persons whatsoever, free and clear of all and all manner of
Encumbrances whatsoever, and that the S. William Maget have in him
self at the time of the sealing and delivering of these presents a
good and lawful right to sell and dispose of the same in manner
as aforesaid in fee simple in witness whereof the S. William Maget
have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year
