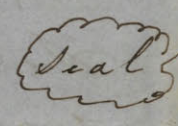


This Indenture made the 30th day

of four hundred & twenty dollars to him paid
I had paid by the said Silas Tollar the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
granted bargained and sold, and by these
present doth grant bargain and sell convey
and confirm unto the said Silas Tollar his
heirs Executors administrators and assigns
for ever: All and singular that certain piece
of parcel of land situated in County of North
ampton and State of North Carolina and
that said piece or parcel of land contains
One hundred & seventy one Acres more or less
Adjoining the lands of Noah Tuttle on
the South Jonas Pope on the East Silas
Tollar on the North Lewis Odum & Mr. Hally
on the west together with all and singular
the tenements hereditaments and appurten-
ances, rents issues and profits thereof and
all the estate, title and interest of the said
Jonas Pope to the said premises or any part
thereof, and the said Jonas Pope hereby
binds himself his heirs administrators Executors
to warrant and for ever defend the title and
title of the said bargained premises and its
appurtenances and the said Silas Tollar his
heirs and assigns forever. Witness whereof I have

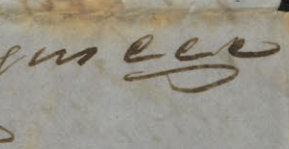
