part Witnesseth that I the said William
B. Lapsiter for and in consideration of the
sum of Six hundred dollars — to me in hand paid
by the said Cornelias Lapsiter the receipt whereof
I hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold and
conferred unto the said Cornelias Lapsiter his
heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract
or parcel of Land containing two Acres with a
Grist Mill and seat and all the appurtenances
and privileges therunto belonging situated on
said Land to have and to hold said Land and
Mill unto the said Cornelias Lapsiter his heirs
and assigns for ever. Said Mill is situated on
or across the stream called Patten's Delight. To have
and to hold the said two Acres and Mill with all
appurtenances and privileges therunto belonging
to him the said Cornelias Lapsiter his heirs and
assigns forever said two Acres of Land & Mill
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
which I do forever warrant and defend the
right & title of said Land & Mill unto him the said
Cornelias Lapsiter his heirs and assigns forever
in witness whereunto I have hereunto set my hand and seal

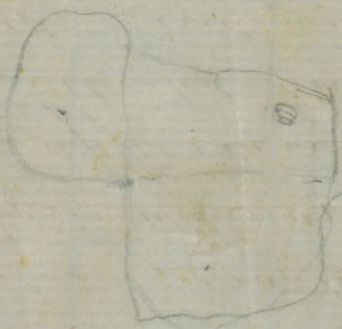
