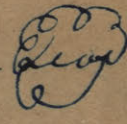

This Indenture made the tenth day of February in
in the year of our lord one thousand Eight hundred
and forty six between Jordan Beale of the first Parts
and Littlebury Futchell of the Second part all of the County
of Hampton and State of North Carolina Witnesses
that the said Jordan Beale for and in consideration of the
Sum of sixty dollars has bargained and by these presents
doth grant bargain sell and deliver to the said Littlebury
Futchell his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract
or parcel of Land Containing fifty Acres but the
same more or less lying in the County & State aforesaid
Bounded as follows beginning at a small bay tree
in Kinchen Pannels line then along with his line to
Jordan Beales line to the line of Henry Lapters heirs
then along Littlebury Futchells line to the Road at two
water oaks in the flat Branch then with the Road to
a white oak Littlebury Futchells Corner then along a line
of marked trees to a cedar tree thence to the beginning
to have and to hold the aforesaid land and premises
with all & every the appertinances there unto belonging
or in any wise appertaining the said Jordan Beale
doth hereby covenant to and with the said Littlebury
Futchell that he hath before the Execution of this Deed
full Right absolute & lawfull authority to sell the said
land and premises and agree hereby to warrant and
forever defend the Right and title of the same to him
the said Littlebury Futchell his heirs and assigns forever
in Witness Where of the said Jordan Beale have here
unto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and
year above written
