

This Indenture Made this twentieth -- Day March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 Seven, Between Shadrach Futrell of the County of Warrington and State of N. Carolina of the One part
 and Elliott Futrell and Littleberry Futrell of the County and State afo. of the other part *Witnesseth*,
 that the Said Shadrach Futrell for and in Consideration of the Sum of eight hundred Silver Dollars
 -- to him in hand paid by the Said Elliott and Littleberry Futrells. Which is hereby Acknowledged and have
 by these presents Bargained sold and Confirmed unto the S. Elliott Futrell and Littleberry Futrell their Heirs
 and Assigns for ever a Certain Tract or (Divident) of Land Situate lying and being in the County and
 State afo. Containing by Estimation, One hundred and Eighty One Acres be the same More or less
 and Bounded as follows (To Wit) Beginning at a pine James Sharrods Corner, then along the Said
 Sharrods Line to a Lightwood Shump in Everett Lapsiters line then along the Said Lapsiters line to
 a Corner Red Oak then along the Said Lapsiters line to a White Oak Eli Tallows Corner then
 S. along a line of Marked Trees to, a pine and two Red Oaks, in a line formerly Called, Loose Carters
 line then Westwardly Course to a Corner, then S. by East along the S. Carters line to a Black Gum
 Standing on the Side of the Road in the Scotchmans Branch then up the Main Run of S. Branch
 to the first Station, With the Appertanances therunto Belonging to them the Said Elliott Futrell and
 Littleberry Futrell their Heirs and Assigns for ever (To Wit) the S. parcel of Land with all
 and singular the Appertanances therunto Belonging to them the Said Elliott Futrell and Littleberry Futrell
 as afo. and the Said Shadrach Futrell both for him Self his Heirs &c. Covenant and Agree to and
 With the Said Elliott and Littleberry Futrells their Heirs and Assigns that he will warrant - and Defend
 the Said Bargained Land and Promises, and every part and parcel thereof from the just Claim
 and Demand of all and Manner of person and Persons Whatsoever free and Clear of all and
 Manner of Incombrances Whatsoever and that the Said Shadrach Futrell have in him Self
 at the time of the Sealing and Delivering of these Presents a good and Lawfull Right to
 Sell and Dispose of the same in fee Simple in Witness whereof I the Said Shadrach
 Futrell have hereto Set my hand and Affixed my Seal the Day and Year
 first Above Written
