

This Indenture made the twenty Second Day of October
In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred between
John Bridgers of the County of Northampton and State of
North Carolina of the one part and Shadrach Futrell of County
and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth, that the S.
John Bridgers for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety
pounds Virg. Money to him in hand paid by the S.
Shadrach Futrell, when is hereby Acknowledged and have by
these presents bargained sold and confirmed unto the S. Shadrach
Futrell his Heirs & Assigns for ever a certain Tract or
Divident of land situated lying and being in the County
aforesaid containing by ~~estimated~~ actual Survey Eighty one
Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows

(To wit) beginning at a pine standing in the Northman Branch of Run
ing down the middle of S. Pasanah to Upper Carters Corner Black Gum
standing on the Road side then along the S. Carters line for thirty five paces
West two Hundred and ten paces to Shadrach Futrells corner then along
his line S. forty seven or West one Hundred and twenty five paces

To the first Station with the appertanences there unto
belonging to him the S. Shadrach Futrell his Heirs & Assigns
for ever, To HAVE & TO HOLD the S. parcel of land with
all and singular the appertanences thereunto belonging to
him the S. Shadrach Futrell as aforesaid - and the S. John Bridgers
doth for his self his Heirs &c. Covenant and agree to
and with the S. Shadrach Futrell his Heirs and Assigns
that he will warrant and defend the S. bargained land and
primefs and every part and parcel thereof from the just
Claim and Demands of all and all manner of persons and
persons whatsoever, free and clear of all and all manner of
Incumbrances whatsoever And that the S. John Bridgers
have in him self at the time of the Sealing and

Delivering of these presents good and lawful right
to sell and dispose of the same in manner as aforesaid
in fee simple in Witness whereof I the S. John Bridgers
have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my Seal
