Beginning at Everit Lapiters corner red oak in Elliot Futrell's line thence north twenty one degrees west one hundred  
and sixteen pole along Everit Lapiters line thence north ten degrees west seventeen and a half poles along said  
Lapiters line to James Sherrods corner stump in said Lapiters line thence along said Sherrods line South  
eight degrees west one hundred and ten poles to Elliot Futrell's corner red oak in said Sherrods line thence  
along said Elliot Futrell's own line South Seventy one degrees east sixty pole to the beginning
