



three hundred & nine acres of Land
Known as the Yallow place approp-
riated to William W Powell (No 2)
beginning at a corner red oak in Woods
woods line running thence the Guttell
line S 24 E 24 poles S 5 1/2 E 13 poles to a cor-
ner blank thence the Guttell line & by his
course N 80 E 180 to a corner white oak
turning then Beals line N 18 W 38
poles to the road then N 2 E 108 poles
to Beals corner Red Oak then N 75-
E 42 poles N 60 1/2 E 62 poles to Beals
corner thence N 9 W 46 pole N 13 W
72 poles to a corner pine then S 8 1/2
W 34 poles S 57 W 113 pole S 75 1/2 W 72 poles
S 80 W 48 poles to Woodards corner pine

then Woodard's line $817\frac{1}{2}$ East - 184 poles
to a corner, then $876\frac{1}{2}$ N 77 pole to the
fire-station.
