I Durhame Hardison being seized

Do offer to sell to A. Fisher manager  
the pine timber and poplar one and back of  
land for the sum of \$400 dollars, payable  
as follows. \$200 on the 30<sup>th</sup> of this month  
by 3 mos note, \$100 payable in 12 months  
after & \$100 payable in two years after

I guarantee the title to this land to give five  
years to have the timber all removed
