Martin County } This 10th of October in
the year of our Lord 1823 between James
Moore junr. and James Hardison junr both
of the County & State aforesaid - witnesseth that
the said James Moore hath for & in consideration
of the sum of seventy five dollars, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, sold, aliened &
confirmed unto the said Jas. Hardison a certain
tract or parcel of Land, lying & being in
Martin County, Bounded & bounded as follows -
(V13) - Beginning at the Poplar Branch at the
main road near deep run Muting House
running ^{down the Poplar branch} nearly a N^o east to Sam^e Moore's
line, then west to a cart path, then nearly south
along a cart path - then along a cart path
nearly East to the main Road - then down the
main road to the beginning containing
fifty acres more or less - To have & to hold
the said Land to him & his heirs forever.
And I James Moore do hereby warrant
& defend unto James Hardison the said
Land free & clear from the claim of any
person or persons whatsoever to him and
his heirs forever - Witness my hand & seal
this 10th day of October 1823 -
