of the County of Martin and State aforesaid
for and in consideration of the
Sum of one hundred and Twenty Dollars
to me in hand paid by Hodge Harrison
of the County of Martin County
and State aforesaid have bargained
Sold Conveyed and delivered and these
Presents do bargain sell convey and deliver
unto the said Hodge Harrison his heirs
assigns &c all the Cypress Timber
both standing and fallen on a certain
Tract or parcel of Land lying in the
County of Martin and State aforesaid
beginning at a white oak on Deep Run
and running to the Head of Lower Island
Marsh thence through the Swamp to
a Short Jag Pine thence running a North
East Course to the Point of the
Juniper Pond thence running a West
Course to E. H. Mariners Line and
thence along her Line to the first
Station containing Over hundred & sixty
acres More or Less by the same
To have and to hold unto the only use and
Benefit of the said Hodge Harrison
his heirs &c with the full use of said Land
to make Roads or any other Conveyance
that may be necessary to get out said
Timber up said Timber during the Term
of Twenty years and no longer
and I Henry Robertson do for my self heirs
and assigns warrant the Right and Title
and interest in said Timber

With the full Privilege of getting off
the Timber or shingles for the Term
Mentioned here in and to the said.
