Hudson at 80 cents one Cart to J Hudson
at one dollar one feather Bed to J Hudson
at one dollar Two Bulls yearlings in the same
mark to James Hudson at Two Dollars
the above sale was lawfully advertised ten days
previously of the day of sale & I the constable
do warrant and defend the title & titles of the
property to Col James Hudson in as full & ample
