My dear Mr. Absolon:

I have your letter of August 17 advising me that you have arrived in the United States. We are glad that your enrollment in the School of Medicine is now definite, and we look forward to including you among the students at Yale. I am enclosing information for new students, a bond and a health blank. The information is quite complete and should answer most of your questions.

I would suggest that between now and September 20 that you come to New Haven and meet the new Assistant Dean, Dr. Thomas R. Forbes. If you will write us in advance, we will give you an appointment at some time convenient both to you and to Dr. Forbes.

I do not know whether you plan to live in Stamford and commute to New Haven during your medical course, or if you plan to live in New Haven which of course is greatly to be preferred. If the latter, I would advise you that we have just had a cancellation of a room in our dormitory which we will be glad to save for you if you will advise us at once. The room will cost \$65 a term or \$195 for the academic year, September to June. You will, of course, have to provide linen (bed linen, towels, etc.).
